Berkshire County—Alf Barbalunga, a Democratic candidate for Berkshire County Sheriff, says that in the interests of full transparency, he is releasing 20 years of audit scores in their entirety, that directly reflected on his performance, while as the Southern Berkshire District Chief Probation Officer: Below are the 22 audit scores completed by three Commonwealth of Massachusetts agencies, with an average of one audit every 9 months and a mean score of 93%. Please note all audits conducted by certified state auditors, with the exception of Probation Service audits, conducted by Regional Supervisors and/or Deputy Commissioners.
